



GRANTS AND LOANS

Building for the future

Over the years, AFC has made bricks and mortar a priority because it understands the importance of church buildings as places where people and communities gather on a regular basis. Churches are the places where rites of passage are celebrated: baptisms, confirmations, weddings, and funerals. How would we celebrate Christmas and Easter without those memorable children's pageants and Holy Week observances? Church buildings are also increasingly serving the needs of the community as a hub of activity and programming for people of all ages. Parish halls are used for public services such as food and clothing banks, legal clinics, language classes for immigrants, health and fitness seminars, and sanctuary for people in distress.

In addition to applications for infrastructure projects, AFC received a number of applications for new and creative ministry programs and theological formation across the country. The grants and loans listed here demonstrate the breadth of exciting ministry undertaken by Canadian Anglicans from coast to coast to coast.

That's why the people of Whitehorse's Christ Church Cathedral applied to AFC for a grant to replace their existing front doors with new ones that are more practical for a northern climate. The doors are now insulated. Frost does not accumulate, and heat does not escape. What a difference a door makes!



MAKING HURON COLLEGE ACCESSIBLE

Huron University College London, ON • Theological College

Huron University College has been educating leaders with heart for over 135 years. Established as an Anglican theological college in 1863 by Bishop Benjamin Cronyn, Huron is the founding institution of Western University, whose alumni are making outstanding contributions in every aspect of civil society around the world. At present, Huron is spearheading an unprecedented model of education allowing students to address our world's most complex challenges. Hence the need to let everyone into the building—with the addition of an outdoor ramp and accessible doors. Acting Dean Daniel Smith says, "Huron needs to be welcoming to all, not just those with sound legs."

DON'T HIDE THOSE LIGHTS UNDER A BUSHEL!

St. Paul's Cathedral Regina, SK • Diocese of Qu'Appelle

As the oldest church in Regina and a heritage property, St. Paul's is a venue for weekly worship and many diocesan and city-wide events. It had come time to replace the lighting, to reduce its power consumption, to brighten things up, and replace old and hazardous sockets. "To say the lighting is poor is an understatement," said Rob Hardwick, Bishop of Qu'Appelle. "The Cathedral plays an incredible role in the life of the diocese and this renewal of the lighting will aid worship in the church, helping especially those with visual difficulties," he added.

LET'S GET THOSE ROOFS REPAIRED

St. Thomas' Anglican Church

Morden, MB • Diocese of Rupert's Land

It does not take much imagination to visualize pails around the church catching drips through the roof, and that familiar plopping sound of water hitting the pail. In addition to receiving an AFC grant and other donations, the people of St. Thomas' sold strawberry milkshakes, sundaes, and



shortcake for three days at the Morden Corn & Apple Festival. Parishioners also dressed up as strawberries and entered a float into the festival's parade. Founded in 1885, St. Thomas is the first and oldest church in Morden and now has a beautiful, new roof. No more leaks. No more drips.

ST. MARY THE VIRGIN ANGLICAN CHURCH

Brandon, MB • Diocese of Brandon

New shingles, roof-venting, vinyl eavestroughs, metal flashings, and downspout pipes were just some of the repairs that St. Mary's completed in their 2019 major building project with the help of an infrastructure grant from the Anglican




Foundation. "Thanks to AFC, we have been given an opportunity to exercise the outward facing ministries of the church to the broader community with a new roof. As a result, a new wave of energy has been bestowed upon us, and the people we serve."

CHRIST CHURCH

Stellarton, NS • Diocese of Nova Scotia and PEI

You won't get lost in Pictou County because the towering steeple at Christ Church serves as a beacon in the community and a guiding light home. It's a thriving place inside, too, with community meals, a café, clothing depot, concerts, and educational programs. But those old and



weather-beaten asphalt shingles on the roof had come to the end of their life span, and Christ Church decided to install a steel roof with the assistance of a grant from AFC. What a difference that roof has made!

ST. ALBAN'S ANGLICAN CHURCH

Ashcroft, BC • Territory of the People

St. Alban's is on a journey to sustainable ministry. In 2016 the church installed LED lighting in the parish hall, reducing their annual hydro consumption by 7%. After that, the installation of high-efficiency furnaces reduced gas billings by 10%. After a 2018 gale-force storm lifted a



portion of the tar and gravel roof, it was replaced with a trussed roof and better insulation, reducing hydro and gas consumption by a further 10%. However, with the recent addition of solar panels on the roof, St. Alban's is now adding energy back into the grid. Any income generated from the surplus will be dedicated to supporting local ministry. St. Alban's is doing its part in making a greener more sustainable world.

AFC BATTLES BAD BOILERS AND WINS!

For Canadian churches, when a boiler goes bad—due to age or an unexpected breakdown—the interrupted flow of heat and hot water means an unwanted cold front is sure to move in. Let's be honest: no one wants to worship in a stained-glass refrigerator. Even more alarming than that possibility, though, is the broader impact a sub-zero chill can have on mission-minded congregations whose buildings serve as community hubs throughout the week. It is undeniably true that the relative comfort of a church building can make a whole lot of community possible. This year the AFC turned up the heat and partnered with three congregations to battle bad boilers and score some big wins for community ministry.

St. Aidan's Anglican Church

Winnipeg, MB • Diocese of Rupert's Land

In January 2019 the boiler unit at St. Aidan's suffered a terminal event. In a city famed for its bitingly cold winters this left parishioners imagining the worst. Could the pianist play in mittens? Would Pastor Dave's aquarium of fish freeze to death in the church office? Thankfully,



with support from the congregation and a grant from AFC, a new boiler was purchased and installed just in time for the 2019–20 heating season.

ST. THEODORE OF CANTERBURY ANGLICAN CHURCH

Woodbridge, ON • Diocese of Toronto

After six decades of faithful service, the increasingly high-maintenance boiler at St. Theodore's was threatening the congregation's ability to support community and ecumenical partnerships. With a morale-boosting grant



from AFC, which encouraged donations from elsewhere, St. Theodore's installed a much more energy-efficient heating system. The resulting savings have enabled new programs, including a monthly dementia-friendly worship service.

HOLY TRINITY ANGLICAN CHURCH

Niagara Falls, ON • Diocese of Niagara

High above Niagara Falls in the historic village of Chippawa sits a church that many describe as a hive of activity. From weekly seniors' group meetings, to the food pantry team constantly working in the kitchen, to the Gently Used Clothing Shoppe, to the grateful members



of Twelve Step programs, Holy Trinity's building is in constant service. Gratefully, a new boiler system, boosted by a grant from AFC is keeping everyone toasty warm... and keeping old man winter in his place!

INDIGENOUS CULTURAL PROGRAMMING

St. Matthews Maryland Community Ministry – 1JustCity, Winnipeg, MB

St. Matthews Maryland is part of 1JustCity, which operates three community outreach sites in three central neighbourhoods in Winnipeg. Indigenous people make up a large part of the communities at these sites, and the goal of the program is to provide healing, support, and community that is culturally sensitive and Indigenous-led, as well as making an impact on reconciliation work in the city. Thanks to a generous grant from the Catholic Apostolic Universal Church Trust Fund, this important ministry can expand its reach in the community.



HOW FIRM A FOUNDATION

St. Stephen's Anglican Church Salvage, NL • Diocese of Central Newfoundland

In 2017 when the church building was declared unsafe and closed to all public access, the parish had some big decisions to make. Let the building go or attempt a major foundation restoration? Within this fishing community of 120 residents, the church is a prominent landmark, the main location for social organization, and a hub of community life. The restoration solution was the right choice. One year later, with the help of a grant from AFC, the building was reopened and church bells rang out across the harbour once again.

SHAKE THOSE FOUNDATIONS

St. James Anglican Church Cacouna, QC • Diocese of Quebec

AFC has partnered with St. James in two phases of their restorative maintenance: repairing the church roof and steeple and more recently the rectory foundation. Many parishioners understand the concerns of sagging beams and crumbling foundations that come with older buildings—and the associated high replacement costs. According to the parish leadership, "The restorations will allow St. James to continue its ministry well into the future. Without many generous contributions including the Anglican Foundation, our parish would be in a very different place going into 2020."

BURSARIES

Leadership

Leadership is always evolving as technology, innovation, and change accelerate. AFC recognizes that in today's fast-paced and complex environment, church leaders need to exhibit qualities such as intellectual versatility: that is, having a broad range of knowledge to be equipped to anticipate and lead change. They need to be authentic and reflective, collaborative and inspirational. Many researchers are saying that one of the most valuable assets of future leaders is their willingness and ability to be creative.

Donors to AFC are making it possible to train such leaders for the Anglican Church of Canada. Student recipients of AFC bursaries for theological education are enrolled in a variety of programs that will impact the church through ordination, chaplaincy, outreach, teaching, writing, and research.

HEADS OF THEOLOGICAL COLLEGES



KARA MANDRYK Henry Budd College, The Pas, MB

An uninformed parody of theological education conjures up images of people in stuffy wood-panelled university classrooms discussing and debating obscure doctrines, disconnected from the "real world." Nothing could be

further from the truth! For the students of Henry Budd College in The Pas, Manitoba, our theological education is deeply connected to community and the local practice of ministry. We seek to honour and respect Indigenous ways of being and learning in all of our courses, with Indigenous and non-Indigenous people together creating a unique learning community.

The vast majority of our students are clergy or catechists, raised up by their communities to lead and minister. Therefore, our theological education is intensely relevant, because we are offering ministry training and biblical and theological studies to those who are already serving their communities, having been recognised as leaders from within those communities.

In our current cultural climate, theological education that is connected to the community is essential, and the intersection of community engagement with the traditional training of theological and biblical studies is vital. We encourage Indigenous Christian leaders to integrate their ways of knowing and being with the wider world of biblical and theological scholarship as they serve in their communities, passing on teachings to others. This chain of connection with traditions, ancestors, and current community is what makes theological education relevant for our culture—a learning that is not separated from community, but deeply rooted in our Anglican and Christian heritage as well as the local expressions of faith-in-practice.



RICHARD TOPPING

Vancouver School of Theology, Vancouver, BC

For anyone who cares about excellence in preaching and worship, pastoral intelligence in counselling and care, deep formation for Christian care, and formation and inspiration for mission in the world God loves, excellent and innovative

theological education is crucial. Never in the history of the Christian church has a thoughtful, generous, and deeply engaged faith been more important for the life of the church and the world. At VST, we are called to educate and form thoughtful, engaged, and generous Christian leaders for the 21st century. TRAINING AND FORMATION OF CHURCH LEADERS



Breaking through the Stained-Glass Ceiling

Chicago, IL • Episcopal Church of the US and Anglican Church of Canada

Over 70 ordained women from the Anglican Church of Canada and the Episcopal Church gathered in October for the Leading Women conference spearheaded by Archbishop Melissa Skelton of the Diocese of New Westminster. Keynote speakers included Bishop Chilton Knudsen, assisting bishop in the Diocese of Washington, and Canon Judy Rois, executive director of the Anglican Foundation of Canada. Knudsen spoke on the trends she saw for the role of women in the church, while Rois discussed the history of the ordination of women in Canada. Rois called her experience of the conference "uplifting and inspiring," as she met women from "diverse ages, cultures and faith journeys... all of whom have broken through the stained-glass ceiling that, in the past, was impenetrable."



WESTERN EDUCATION COLLABORATIVE ANGLICAN NETWORK (WECAN)

Winnipeg, MB • Theological Colleges

WECAN is a group of educators, program administrators, designers, and judicatory leaders who are passionate about training church leaders in western and northern Canada, with a special sensitivity to Indigenous realities and cultural context.

St. John's College in Winnipeg hosted a three-day conference that focused on competency-based theological education, ministry identity, and spiritual formation. A participant said, "We are excited to see how our teaching will be reshaped by this encounter."



DEEP ROOTS

Fredericton, NB • Diocese of Fredericton

This two-day event took place to help the diocese address what it means to be a missional people in today's culture and context. This gathering was aligned with the diocese's use of a resource called *Surprise the World* by Michael Frost, who uses the acronym "bells" (bless, eat, listen, learn, sent) to enable people to think through their mission and ministry.

KIDS HELPING KIDS FUND



ST. JAMESTOWN HOMEWORK CLUB

St. Peter & St. Simon-the-Apostle Anglican Church Toronto, ON • Diocese of Toronto

Each weekday after school, learning support is provided for 25 children between 6–12

is provided for 25 children between 6–12 years of age. The majority of children come refugee families. In a supportive learning

from new immigrant and refugee families. In a supportive learning environment, the program offers enrichment in arts and culture, life skills, social engagement, and leadership development. After 15 years, many graduates of the program are now in post-secondary school, fully part of the upcoming generation of young Canadians.



HAY RIVER SOUP KITCHEN

Hay River, NT • Diocese of the Arctic

The mission of the Soup Kitchen is to help support the less fortunate and recovering with an open heart, a healthy meal, and educational resources. It provides a hot lunch to local students three days each week.

REGINA FOOD FOR LEARNING

Regina, SK • Diocese of Qu'Appelle

Since 1988, RFFL has provided children in low-income communities with nutritious food and encourages children to attend school with a positive outlook each day. For 30 years, RFFL has provided 11,000 nutritious snacks, breakfast, and lunch to 865 students every month.



PARENTING TOGETHER

St. Mary with St. Mark Mayo, YT • Diocese of Yukon

Gathering at the Mayo Curling Club, the First Nation of Nacho Nyak Dun provides transportation to many of the 37 parents, grandparents, and children who gather for a

community feast. There are opportunities for adults and children to learn new skills, problem-solving abilities, and communication strategies.



MUSIC THERAPY AND HEARTBEAT SONGS

Philip Aziz Centre / Emily's House Children's Hospice Toronto, ON • Diocese of <u>Toronto</u>

At Toronto's first children's hospice opened in 2013, integrated respite paediatric palliative care is offered in a homelike setting with 24-

hour medical care. Music therapy helps meet the physical, emotional, psychological, and spiritual needs of children at the end of their life, incorporating music into play and recreation, engaging families in songwriting, and self-expression. A special program, funded in part by AFC, can incorporate the sound of a child's heartbeat into a song created as a legacy for the family. Parents and loved ones are profoundly moved and treasure the memory, which they can return to and listen to for a lifetime of comfort.


