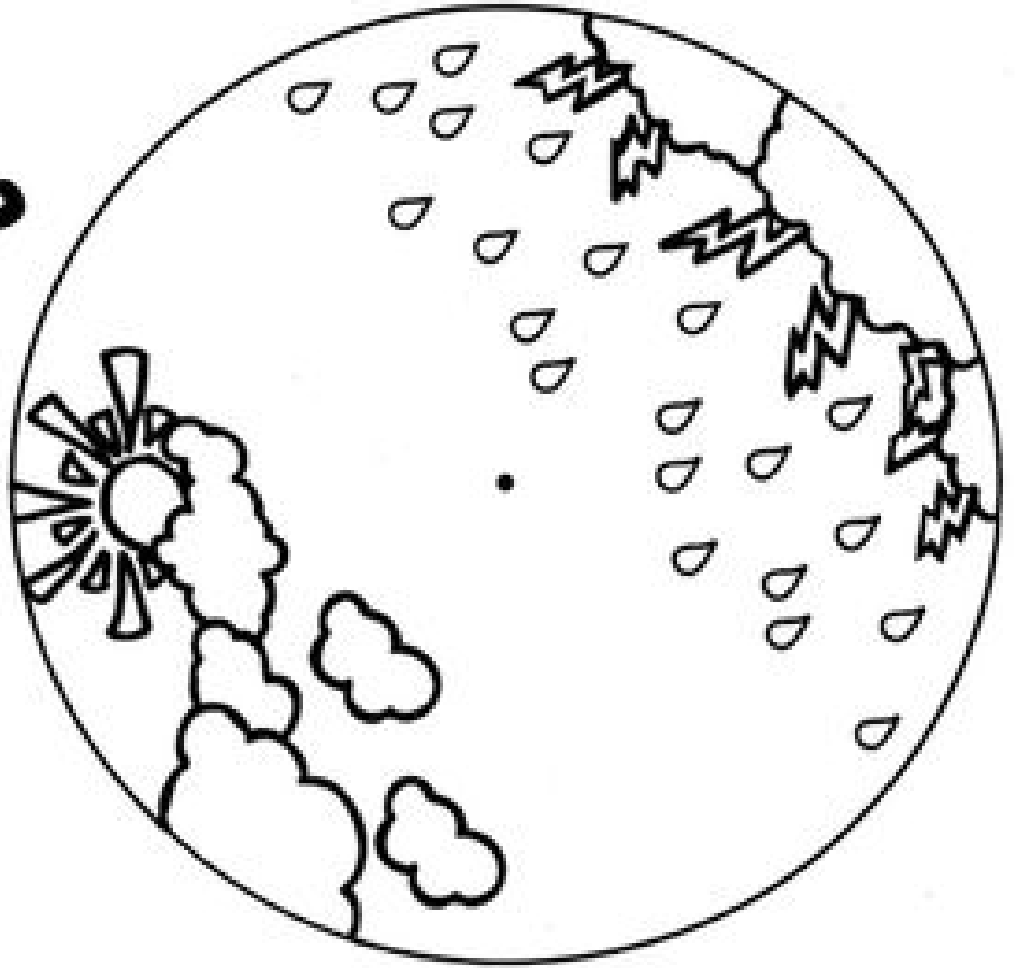

How to make a paper boat

1



Start with an A4 sheet of paper.
Fold in half, top to bottom.

2



To find centre, fold in the
other direction and unfold.

3



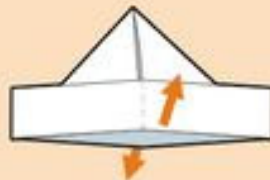
Fold corners down
using centre fold as a guide.

4



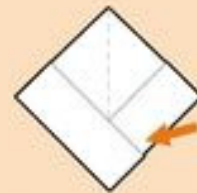
Fold flaps up on
both sides.

5



Put thumbs in middle
and open out...

6



...until it makes a square.
Tuck corners of one flap
under the other.

7



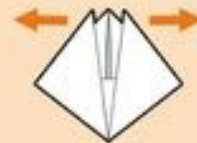
Fold up at both sides.

Put thumbs in middle
and open out again...

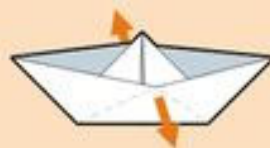
...until it makes a square.
Pull corners out...

... and press flat.

Open out to make boat shape.

Jesus Stills a Storm (Mark 4, 35-41)

³⁵ On that day, when evening had come, he said to them, “Let us go across to the other side.” ³⁶ And leaving the crowd behind, they took him with them in the boat, just as he was. Other boats were with him. ³⁷ A great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that the boat was already being swamped. ³⁸ But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke him up and said to him, “Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?” ³⁹ He woke up and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, “Peace! Be still!” Then the wind ceased, and there was a dead calm. ⁴⁰ He said to them, “Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?” ⁴¹ And they were filled with great awe and said to one another, “Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?”
