Today, we have some disappointing news to share with you. We have made the incredibly difficult decision to cancel Camp Manitou summer camp programs for 2021, in response to the ongoing global pandemic caused by the COVID-19 virus.

Having to cancel Camp Manitou for the second year in a row is disappointing for many campers, parents, and staff; however, we feel it is in everyone's best interest. At this point, there are too many uncertainties, particularly, with how long the precautionary measures currently in place to limit the spread of COVID-19 will last. Additionally, as Camp Manitou is isolated and requires campers to be in close proximity to one another during their duration at camp, we feel that it is unsafe and logistically unrealistic to bring campers together. The safety of the Camp Manitou community is our first priority.

We thank everyone for their understanding and wish everyone a safe, healthy, and happy summer in 2021. We look forward to operating again with our regular programming as soon as we can safely do so.
