We are communicating with you regarding several matters relating to the forthcoming Diocesan Synod which will take place in Sault Ste. Marie, from Thursday morning, May 11, 2023, to 12:15 pm on Saturday, May 13, 2023.

In view of financial constraints <u>we wish to avoid</u> any misunderstandings regarding travel and out-of-pocket costs. Insofar as costs are concerned, please note the following:

- 1. Incumbents under a Letter of Permission are not members of Synod but are permitted Courtesies of the Floor (they may speak but have no vote). Incumbents in this situation would have their expenses covered by their parish.
- 2. Licensed honourary assistants are members of Synod. Their expenses may be paid by their parish by prior arrangement or by themselves.
- 3. Honourary assistants with a Letter of Permission are not members of Synod, as they hold their Synod membership in another Diocese. They are welcome as visitors and cover their own expenses.
- 4. Retired clergy that are not presently licensed and clergy on leave are welcome to attend Synod as visitors at their own expense.

Many of our retired clergy holding the Bishop's License, as well as those with Letters of Permission, do not attend Synod. COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

It is recommended strongly that delegates wear a well-fitted, well-constructed mask when Synod is in session, during the opening liturgy, and in other indoor and close-contact settings over the days of our gathering. Respirators and medical masks provide the best protection. One's mask should completely cover nose, mouth, and chin.

Please note that, at this time, Algoma's COVID-19 Vaccination Policy remains in effect. Individuals serving in leadership ministry roles have been entrusted with responsibilities that include protection of the vulnerable, and the conscientious regard of others both within and outside the community of Christian faith. Included among the people serving in the Diocese who are required to be immunized with COVID-19 vaccines approved by Health Canada, unless legally exempt, are:

- all clergy holding the Archbishop's license or permission;
- all licensed lay workers;
- all diocesan staff;
- deanery officials;
- Synod Delegates and Alternate Delegates;

Therefore, apart from legal exemption, all officials of, and delegates to Synod must be vaccinated. If those elected to serve in the latter capacity have chosen not to be vaccinated in accordance with the policy duly elected vaccinated alternate delegate should be prepared to go in their place.
