## HELPFUL HINTS TO FIND THE BEST RESOURCES FOR YOUR MINISTRY...

Search online. Websites have free or inexpensive resources that allow you to customize your resources and print only what you need.

Explore multiple uses. 'Sunday School' resources can be used for other types of children's ministry, such as after school programs, family days and camps.

Be aware of Copyright restrictions. Some print, online and video materials do not permit use in churches without an additional license. Some do not include permission to photocopy.

Shop local. Go to your nearest Christian book store and shop their selection of curriculum and books of stories, games, and activities.

Invest in multimedia. Video and music media are as integral to children's ministry as print and craft material. Diversifying your media enables you to engage the children's interest on multiple levels – they learn better!

Know your budget. It will need to cover supplies and snacks as well as curriculum.

Know your gifts. Are your leaders good a crafts, storytelling, drama, sports? Choose a curriculum that reflects their natural abilities.
